## **RULES & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

(complete rules are found in the POA rulebook; the following will answer some of the most commonly asked questions; it also lists WVPC show information & 4 exceptions to the POA rulebook)

- CLASS AWARDS: Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>
- ENTRY FEES: \$3.50 per class or \$10 for the day for <u>each pony and rider/driver combination</u> *plus* \$1 judge's fee for <u>each pony and rider/driver combination</u>

No refunds will be issued for cancelled classes or for any other reason.

- No stalls available
- Open to ponies 56" & under (ALL PONIES ARE SUBJECT TO MEASUREMENT; PRESENTING A PERMANENT MEASUREMENT CARD FROM A RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION IS ACCEPTABLE)
- Open to riders 18 years and under as of Jan. 1, 2014
- No cross entries between classes #10, #11 & #12
- If entering Leadline Equitation, child may also enter Costume, but may not enter any other classes
- No stallions in Leadline Equitation or as leadline Costume entries, regardless of the age of the person leading pony
- The handler in Leadline Equitation or with leadline Costume entries must be at least 14 years of age
- No loping/cantering in games in harness. If pony breaks to a lope, must come to complete halt before continuing.
- Entrants must wear their show number on their back or have one number on each side.
- Boots must be worn by all entrants in all events (including Leadline handlers)
- Neat & clean short sleeve shirts (not T-shirts or tank tops) are acceptable.
- Unruly, unmanageable or unsafe entries will be dismissed.
- Game riders must ride course alone (cannot be led through course; this is not a schooling show.)
- In all timed events, pony must go at a trot or faster through the majority (75%) of the course
- A rider may ride only one pony in a game class. Riders must compete in their proper age category and may not enter an older age division.
- THIS SHOW WILL BE CONDUCTED & JUDGED ACCORDING TO PONY OF THE AMERICAS CLUB, INC. OFFICIAL HANDBOOK (copy will be available at show office) with the following exceptions:
  - 1. no stallions to be exhibited in any class by youth 18 yrs. or under (including Leadline & leadline Costume)
  - 2. use of approved safety helmet is recommended, but not required
  - 3. members of immediate family may ride/drive same pony in same game class or performance class where entries perform individually
  - **4.** an assistant shall be permitted to lead a pony into arena for game events
